Amalaya offers wines that are high-elevation expressions of Argentina’s signature varietals. The grapes are sourced from vineyards located 5,400 to 5,900 ft above sea level in the Calchaquí Valley, which sits in the northwestern region of Argentina. This region stands out as one of the highest vineyards in the world, and is characterized by a dry climate and rocky, sandy soils that have proven to be the ideal growing conditions for grapevines.
