Artezin Zinfandel is instantly recognizable as a classic, fruit-forward, Zinny Zin. This signature style offers a full-bodied wine with round tannins and moderate alcohol.

Artezin Mendocino County Zinfandel represents a blend of the best sustainably farmed grapes from family-owned vineyards in the ridgelines and benchlands of the Ukiah Valley.

WINEMAKER NOTES

“Ruby red in color this wine has indigo blue and violet hues. There is a concentration of juicy bright cherry, pomegranate and boysenberry aromas followed by darker notes of cassis and pepper. Flavors are abundant, led by raspberry and currants, surrounded by baking spices of clove, cinnamon and allspice. On the palate, one will experience a plush well-rounded mounthfeel to a lingering finish of fine grained tannins up lifting the fruit with hints of toasty French oak.”

Mendocino’s Mediterranean climate produces warmer days providing optimal ripening conditions. Cool evenings extend the growing season, helping Artezin Zinfandel retain balanced acidity and good structure.
