For centuries, farmers in the middle of the Cafayate desert made offerings hoping for the miracle of a bountiful harvest. "Amalaya" translates to "hope for a miracle" in the native Indian language, and it has come to represent Donald Hess' miracle of finding water in the Cafayate Desert of Salta, Argentina.

Located at 5,900 feet above sea level in northwest Argentina, the Calchaquí Valley stands out as one of the highest vineyards in the world. It is characterized by a dry climate, with no more than 6 inches of annual rainfall, with significant temperature variation and rocky, sandy soils.
