For centuries, farmers in the middle of the Cafayate desert made offerings hoping for the miracle of a bountiful harvest. "Amalaya" translates to "hope for a miracle" in the native Indian language, and it has come to represent Donald Hess' miracle of finding water in the Cafayate Desert of Salta, Argentina.

The vineyards are located at 5,900 feet above sea level, in the Calchaquí Valley, northwest of Argentina. This region stands out as one of the highest vineyards in the world, characterized by its dry climate with no more than 150mm annual rainfall, with significant thermal range; rocky and sandy soil.
